She was a fundraiser, assisted with the development of policy and procedure, provided support and moved furniture. Eleanor was known for her approach. Her genuine love and dedication to women accessing services was apparent. She was a group facilitator. Many remained in contact after their work with the Centre was over. Her cooking of group was always celebrated (she cooked turkey dinner with all the help of the staff and volunteers entirely by her). Eleanor also served as Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Past Chairperson and Community Representative up until her death in 2008.



In 2006, The Interlake Women's Resource Centre hosted an open house of their new facility at 87-5th Avenue. The facility was named "Ellie's Place" in honor of her contribution and the fulfillment of her wish to see the Centre have its own



In September of 2008, she was made a lifetime member of the Interlake Women's Resource Centre. Eleanor received the Golden Heart Award given by Pam Naylor of Diamond Beach, for outstanding community volunteerism.

In May of 2009, Eleanor passed away surrounded by the many people who loved her. She will be fondly remembered for her cheerful words and smile, and her dedication to ensuring that programs and services are available to women in the Northeast Interlake.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The Interlake Women's Resource Centre provides support to assist women 18 YEARS of age or older within the service area in obtaining post-secondary education in situations where the student requires financial assistance to pursue those goals. APPLICATION DEADLINE
